

Umbrella School

My Village Learning Center is registered as an umbrella school with the State of Florida. Parents have the option of either registering their homeschooled child with the county that they live in or under an umbrella school to comply with the state's truancy laws.

To register with our Umbrella School

Step 1: If your family is registered for in-person My Village Classes, you should have an account on our website. Login to the account and add your child to the Umbrella School "Class" on the website. The class is found under the 'How to' Tab, then click the 'Register for My Village Classes' Tab. Scroll to the Other Classes chart and select the Umbrella School Class and add your child by clicking their name and the 'Register' button. This will generate a \$40 invoice.

Step 2: Pay the invoice.

Step 3: Provide the following documents:

1. Provide a copy of their birth certificate
2. Copy of Immunization Records OR Exemption
3. Copy of Physical within the past 3 months

Once these things are completed, you do not need to send in a physical every year. To reenroll the following year, the fee is only \$40 per family. Students are not required to be enrolled in our umbrella school in order to attend My Village classes.

If your child is currently enrolled in a private or public school, we can request these documents directly from the school for you.

To register with your county:

Go to your county's webpage (For Example: Martinschools.org) and follow the directions to file a Letter of Intent. This lets the county know that you intend on homeschooling your child. There are two main requirements aside from the Letter of Intent.

1. Maintain a portfolio of your child's work for 2 years.
2. Have a Florida Certified Teacher evaluate your child one calendar year after the date you registered to homeschool. (We provide this service at My Village).
