



2025-26 Tuition and Fees Schedule

Monthly Tuition (10 months, August - May)

Registration and Other Fees

Application fee

\$25 per student (new families only, waived for returning families.) This fee is required both for new students who have a spot in the program and those who are on a waiting list.

Registration fees

\$100 per student once they are confirmed to have a seat in a class.

Book Fees

Some classes have specific books that are needed (TBD). Parents will be billed accordingly.

Supply Fees

Included if enrolled before classes begin with August tuition. For students enrolled mid-year the supply fee is \$40 per student per day of the week they attend. For example, students will be charged \$120 (\$40 x3) if they attend three days per week. This supply fee covers basic personal supplies like crayons, markers, pencils, colored pencils, supply box, and a My Village T-shirt and various other supplies as needed. Students enrolled in an art class may have an additional supply fee.

Invoice Fee for Scholarship Students (as needed)

If My Village provides an invoice to be presented to StepUp for reimbursement, there is a \$25 fee per invoice (monthly invoices only).

Math and Language Arts Options (1st - 5th Grade) **(no sibling discount)**

Teachers work with students in-person (up to 4 students at a time) on Math and/or Language Arts in small groups. Students must attend at least 2 days a week to be enrolled in this program.

Small Group Registration fees

\$160 for one subject (Math OR Language Arts.)

\$240 for both subjects (Math AND Language Arts)

This registration fee includes workbooks. Tuition for this service is based on the number of times per week the student works in small groups while at My Village.

<u>Number of sessions/week</u>	<u>Rate</u>

3 - 4	\$200/month

Example #1: A student registered to attend Mondays and Wednesdays can be registered for small groups and work on their math OR language arts once a day on each day (2 sessions per week.) The tuition would be \$100/month. Students will continue to work on their workbooks at home.

Example #2: A student registered for 3 days a week of attendance and both math can work on math and language arts while at My Village; one session for Math and one session for Language Arts for a total of 6 sessions per week. The tuition would be \$300/month.

Individual Tutoring Rates (K-5th grade)

\$35 per 30 minute session

\$50 per 45 minute session

Individual Tutoring Rates (6th-9th Grade)

\$55 per 50 minute session

Math and Language Arts Options (6th-9th grade) **(no sibling discount)**

Students can be pulled from extra-curricular classes to work in small groups on Math and/or Language Arts in-person (up to 4 students at a time). Students must attend at least 2 days a week to be enrolled in this program. There are 3 levels of support that are available.

Option #1: Small Groups, Level 1

Small Group, Level 1 Registration Fee

\$160 for one subject (Math OR language arts.)

\$240 for both subjects (Math AND Language Arts)

Teachers provide the most support at this level and most students will be able to complete their curriculum by the end of the academic year without additional support at home. My Village will provide a curriculum and in-person teachers. Tuition for this service is based on the number of times per week the student is pulled from class to work on Miacademy. Parents can choose Math or Language Arts or both. For students registered for both, they will split the time ($\frac{1}{2}$ for LA and $\frac{1}{2}$ for Math.)

Option #2: Small Groups, Level 2

Students enrolled in Small Groups, Level 2 will not likely complete their curriculum during the academic year and will need more support at home in addition to in-person teacher support. Parents are responsible for providing curriculum.

<u>Number of sessions per week</u>	<u>Rate per month</u>
2	\$ 80
3	\$120
4	\$160

Option #3: Small Groups, Level 3

Students enrolled in the Small Groups, Level 3 work more independently on curriculum that has been provided by the parent. Students require minimal support with the in-person teacher making sure students stay on task and answer questions as they arise.

Up to 4 sessions	\$ 40
