

2025-26 Math and Language Arts Options

1st-5th Grade

How it works

For students who are enrolled in the program, we use an online program called Miacademy. Students go to Small Group 1-2 times per day, depending on their needs and whether or not they are using the program at home. The teacher will prepare materials for each subject, monitor their progress and be there for any questions or extra support. Although you may enroll your child in a wide range of classes through the program, we only monitor Math and Language Arts.

Small Group Miacademy will be available for Primary B, C, D, Tween and Teen classes. Primary A will have these core subjects in their classroom and may be enrolled in Individual Tutoring, however, Miacademy is typically not a good option for kindergarteners. Registration options are available for both Language Arts AND/OR Math. Students are placed on the small group schedule with both their personal interests in mind and the type of classes being offered. The final schedule assignments are at the discretion of the directors. Contact Lisa with any questions.

Language Arts

We have experienced Reading Specialists to help students with their language arts needs. They use research-based curriculum and techniques to provide services to students throughout the day. Math

Math tutoring is offered on a limited basis considering their level and our availability. Please include any requests for math tutoring upon registration.

6th-9th Grade

Option #1: Miacademy

Parents can choose Math or Language Arts or both. For students registered for both, they will split the time ($\frac{1}{2}$ for LA and $\frac{1}{2}$ for Math.) We provide laptops that remain on campus. The teacher will prepare materials for each subject, monitor their progress and be there for any questions or extra support. Although you may enroll your child in a wide range of classes through the program, we only monitor Math and Language Arts.

Tuition for this service is based on the number of times per week the student is pulled from class to work on Miacademy. The sessions are longer than K-5th grade.

Option #2: FLVS Flex Support

Students enrolled in FLVS Flex can work on their classes at My Village. Parents are responsible for enrolling their child with FLVS, however, we will provide dedicated time to work on their assignments, monitor progress and communicate with parents. We provide laptops that remain on campus.

Option #3: Study Hall

Students enrolled in Study Hall can bring their own curriculum and will need to work independently. The supporting staff will not teach their curriculum or provide progress reports. They are there to make sure students stay on task and provide a dedicated quiet time to work on their own homeschool curriculum. Parents will need to provide a laptop or tablet, if needed.
