

# Small Group Academic Support

## COTA Location (Grades 1st - 5th only)

My Village Learning Center offers a Small Group Academic Support program using Miacademy for students at our COTA location. This program provides structured time during the school day for students to work on core academic subjects in a supervised and supportive learning environment.

Students enrolled in this option will be **pulled from select classes during the academic day** to work on either **Language Arts or Math**, depending on the subject for which they are registered.

This program supports homeschooling families by providing accountability, structure, and academic assistance while students are on campus.

## What MVLC Provides

During Small Group Academic Support sessions, MVLC provides:

- A **dedicated workspace** for focused learning
- **Computers for student use while on campus**
- **An experienced teacher** to supervise and support students
- **Manipulatives, extra worksheets, and supplemental materials** to reinforce learning
- **Encouragement and guidance** to help students stay motivated and on track
- Assistance with navigating the Miacademy platform and answering questions
- Communication with parents regarding student progress when needed

Students work independently within the Miacademy curriculum while receiving support from a teacher when questions arise.

# Student Responsibilities

Students participating in this program are expected to:

- Stay focused and engaged during instruction and work sessions
- Work diligently on assigned Miacademy lessons
- Follow all MVLC Student Handbook behavior expectations
- Transport required materials or workbooks between home and MVLC when necessary
- Accept teacher guidance and redirection when needed

Students who repeatedly refuse to work or misuse their time may not be able to continue in the program.

## Technology

MVLC provides **computers for student use while they are on campus**, and students are supervised by a teacher during their scheduled session.

Because Miacademy is an online curriculum:

- **Students must also have access to a computer at home.**
- Some coursework may need to be completed outside of MVLC hours.

Parents are encouraged to **sit with their child while completing Miacademy lessons at home** to support learning and monitor online activity.

---

## Parent Involvement

My Village Learning Center operates as a **hybrid homeschool program**, and parents remain the **primary educators** for their children.

While MVLC provides support during the school day, parents play an important role by:

- Monitoring their child's progress
- Helping ensure lessons are completed
- Supporting academic learning at home when needed
- Providing a pair of headphones for their child to keep at MVLC for use during Miacademy lessons

Strong parent involvement helps students stay on track and succeed in the program.

## Grades and Progress

Grades and academic progress are **generated directly through the Miacademy platform** based on lesson completion, quizzes, and assessments.

Parents receive **their own login credentials to the Miacademy parent portal**, which allows them to monitor:

- Lesson completion
- Quiz and test scores
- Overall academic progress

MVLC teachers monitor student progress during class sessions and provide support, but **grades themselves are determined by the Miacademy system**.
