

Small Group Math Support

At the New Hope campus (6th - 10th grade), **math support is offered in small-group sessions during the academic day**. Because math is often the subject students need the most support with, the learning center provides structured time for students to work through their math curriculum with teacher guidance. Students are **typically pulled from class once per academic day** to participate in small-group math support.

Small-group math support is currently available for students using:

- **Miacademy**
- **MiaPrep**

During these sessions, students:

- Work through math lessons with **teacher supervision**
 - Ask questions and receive guidance when needed
 - Stay accountable for completing assignments
 - Build confidence in problem-solving and foundational math skill

Students Enrolled in FLVS classes

Students who use **Florida Virtual School (FLVS)** as part of their homeschool curriculum are welcome to **work on their assignments while at My Village Learning Center**.

However, parents should understand that **support for FLVS coursework is limited**, as FLVS courses are taught by FLVS instructors and follow their own pacing and requirements.

Students using FLVS may:

- Work on assignments during designated academic time
- Use learning center computers when available
- Receive general encouragement and supervision while working
